

Need to file a supplemental health plan claim?



Follow these steps if you have a UnitedHealthcare Accident Protection, Critical Illness Protection and Hospital Indemnity Protection plan

Steps to file a claim

- 1. If you're enrolled as a UnitedHealthcare Medical member along with a Supplemental Health plan, Benefit Assist technology helps to identify potential supplemental health claims. Many claims may be paid automatically.* For other claims, UnitedHealthcare may contact you** and help you submit a claim on your behalf.
- 2. If you're not enrolled as a UnitedHealthcare Medical member, or would like to file your claim yourself, call **1-888-299-2070** or visit myuhcfp.com and have the following information ready to start the claim process:
 - ✓ Employer's name and location
 - ✓ Your full name and Social Security number
 - ✓ Your complete address and phone number
 - Marital status and number of dependents
- ✓ Date of birth
- ✓ Last day you worked
- ✓ Details of medical event
- Physician's name, address and phone number
- ✓ Dates of treatment

Access your claim information 24/7 and check the status of a submitted claim

- Click "Returning Member? > Sign In"-the first time you log in, you will need your Group ID 390048 and Group Name AlerisLife
